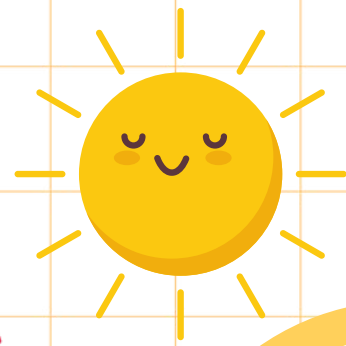

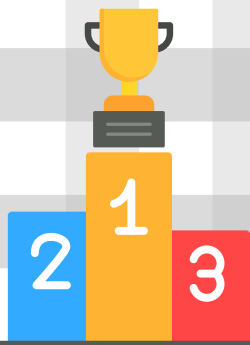
Class Meeting

Before the end of 2nd Semester, we will have a meeting with parents about report distribution, in this meeting, we will inform the Students' progress.

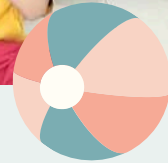

Class Meeting

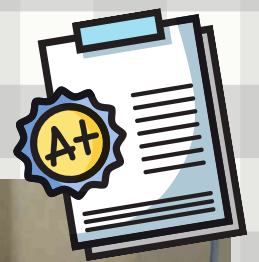
After finishing their final semester exams, the students of Grade 4A at Westin School participated in an energetic Class Meeting that celebrated sportsmanship and teamwork.

This day was a perfect blend of joy, learning, and celebration—marking a memorable closing to the semester for Grade 4A.



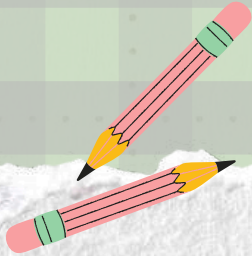
