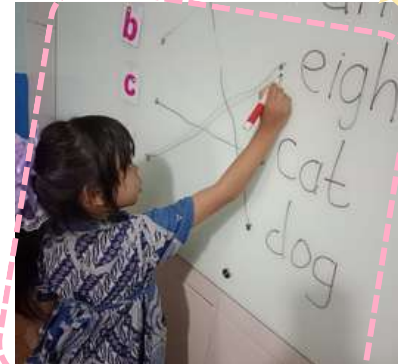

- 6. Learning about hygiene, nutrition, and healthy eating habits.*

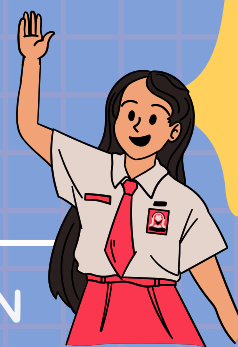

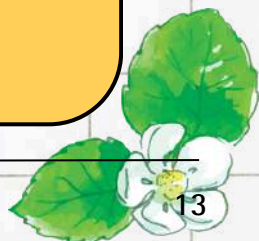
Gym Session

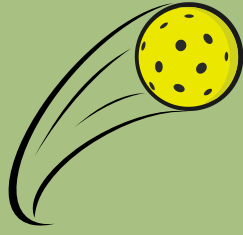

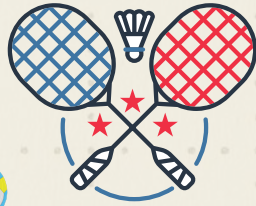
Week of test With Us

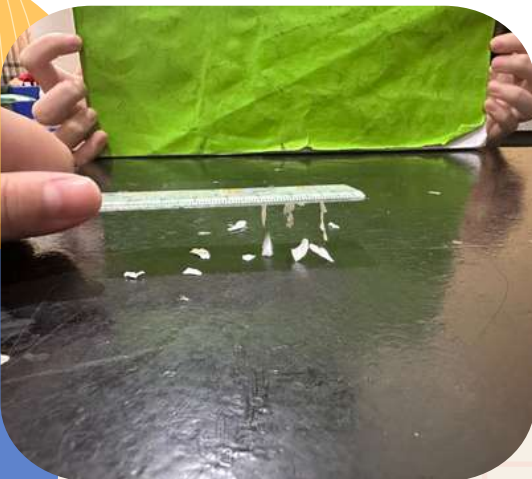
STATIC ELECTRICITY

Static electricity is an imbalance of electric charges, created when electrons transfer between objects, often through rubbing (friction). This imbalance causes one object to become negatively charged (excess electrons) and the other positively charged (electron deficit). The stored, or "static," charge can then attract or repel other charged objects or discharge as a spark or shock when it finds a path to flow away.



EXAMPLE

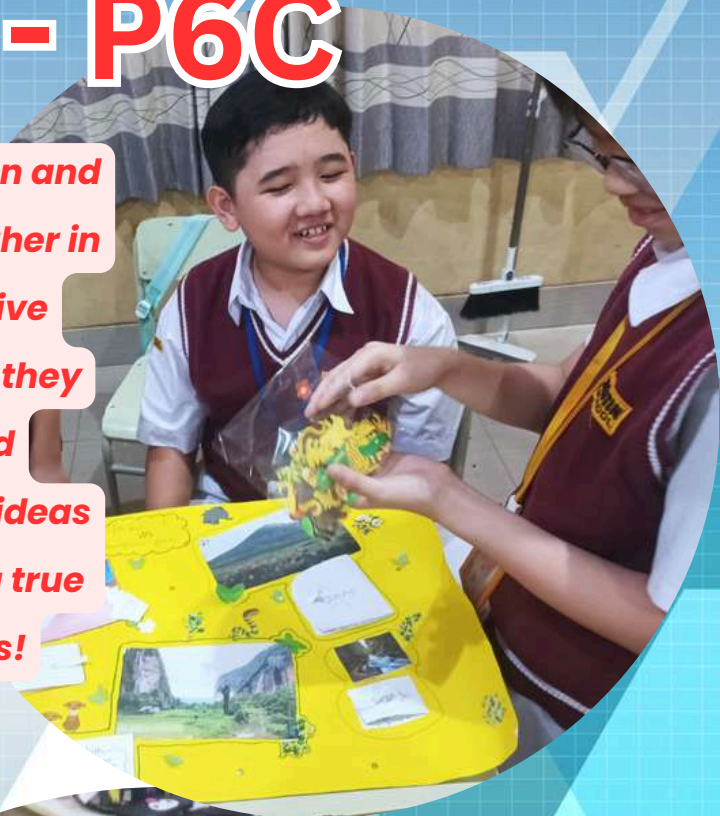
A plastic ruler rubbed with dry hair through hair acquires a negative charge by picking up electrons. It can then attract small bits of paper, by altering the distribution of their originally neutral electric charge. Electric charges can be released suddenly.

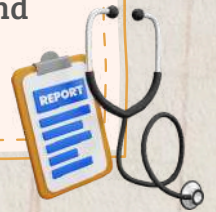

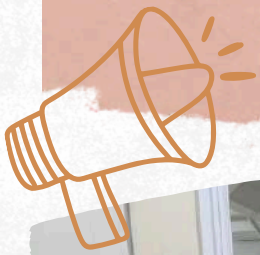


DEVELOPING STRONG ENGLISH SPEAKING HABITS

The goal is to ensure that their minimum scores meet the KKTP/KKM standards, thereby avoiding the need for remedial work.

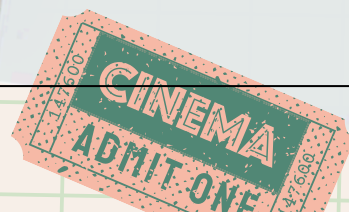

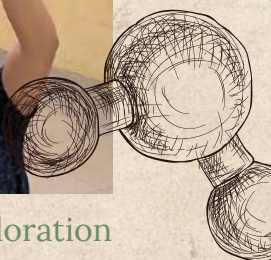

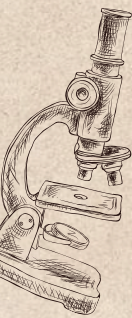


CLASS PROFILE

Science Experiments Involving Biology, Physics, Chemistry

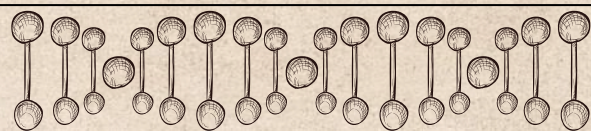
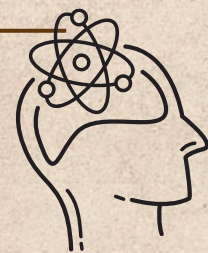
