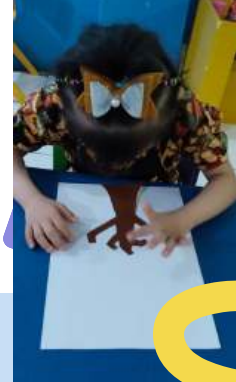

# PAINTING TREE WITH A FORK

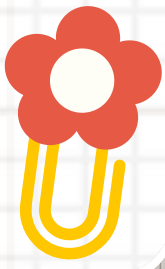


Our K1 students enjoyed a fun art activity. They painted a tree, especially the leaves, by using a fork.

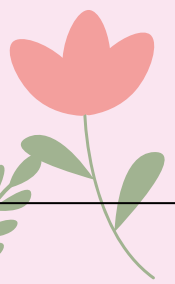

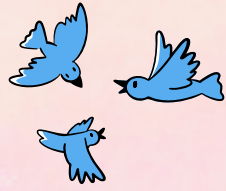

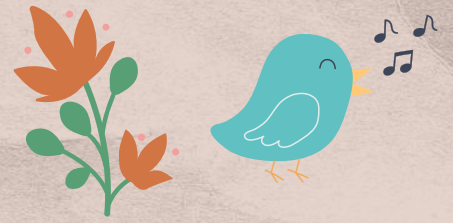




## Time to Study Tour

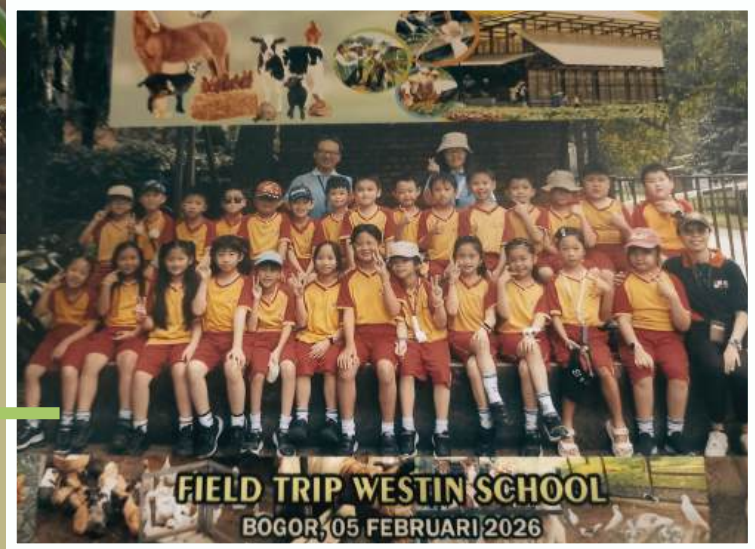
## STUDY TOUR TO KUNTUM FARM FIELD

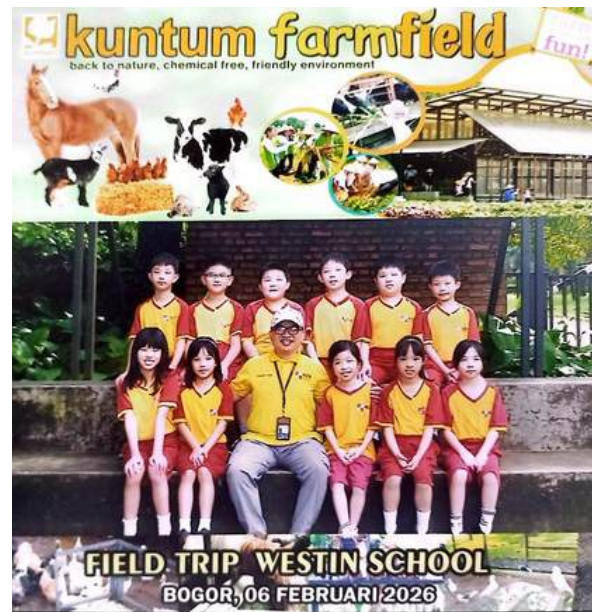

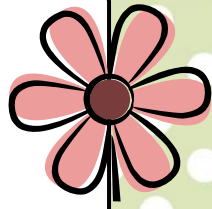


# P5C

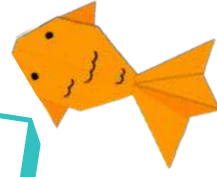

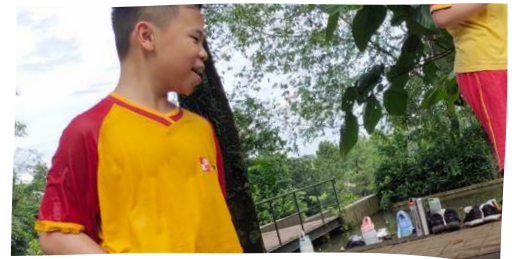
## Goes to Kuntum!

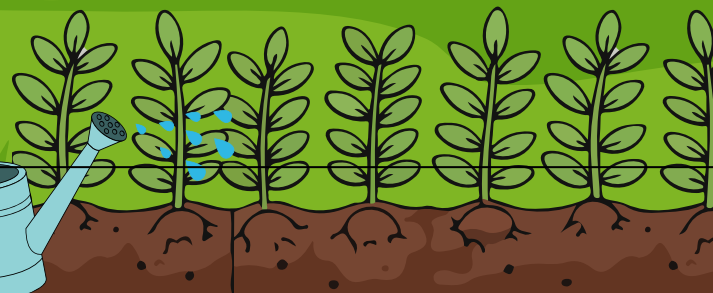
In the art and craft class, the students joyfully paint beautiful pictures, color them with bright crayons, and create fun facial expressions using clay.

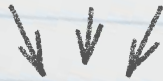

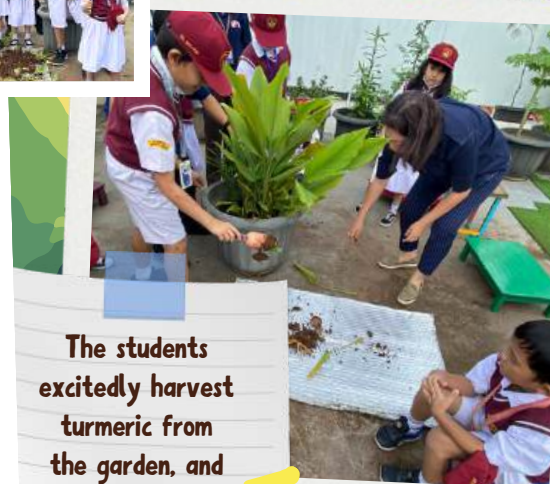

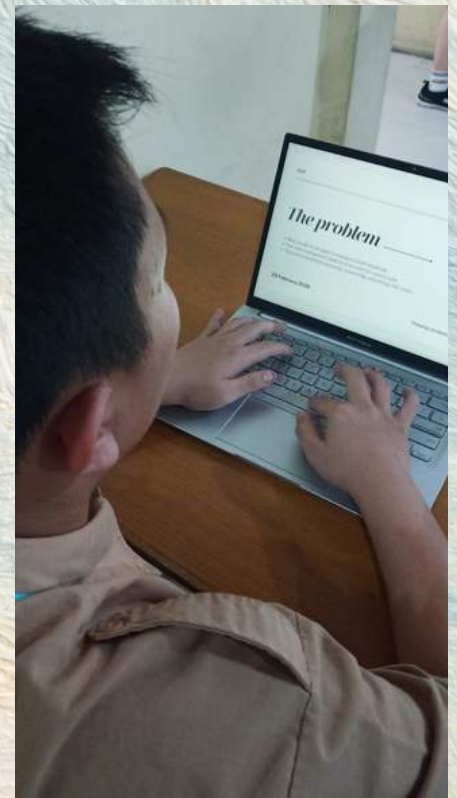
# ART & LITERACY FESTIVAL
